

COVID-19 PUBLIC PROCEDURE

BUS

- Limit number of passengers to 60% occupancy
- Crew members will be responsible for opening and closing doors to reduce contact points
- Provide hand sanitizer to passengers before entering vehicle
- Latex gloves will be available to passengers (optional if they want)
- Collect waste (gloves, tissue, etc.) in garbage bin upon leaving vehicle

CHECK-IN

- Guests will remain in marked off, designated areas to stand during check-in process
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the counter
- Provide seating and social distancing upon completion

BOAT

- Limit number of passengers to 60% occupancy
- Guests will remain 6ft apart when lining up to board
- Hand sanitizer will be provided upon boarding and throughout the duration of the excursion
- Crew wears latex gloves when handling food/drink
- Guests should not do any handling of common items such as coolers, lids, serving containers, vehicle doors, and so on – this is what the crew members are there for!
- Guests will be encouraged to keep safe social distancing during the excursion

CLEANING THE EQUIPMENT

MASK/SNORKEL & FINS & BELTS

- Gear will be cleaned 3x per day (before, between, and after each excursion)
- There will be an adequate supply of equipment for each guest

BOAT

- Disinfect entire boat 3x per day (before, between, and after each excursion)
- Disinfect frequently touched surfaces (handrails, bars tops, doors) throughout the duration of the excursion

BUS

- Clean and disinfect vehicles before morning pickups, between morning and afternoon pickups, and after afternoon drop-offs
- Display last timestamp bus was cleaned and checked (like in public restrooms)
